Gate Steward, Ring steward, Announcer assistant/ribbons, scribe, score runner, spotter, timers, Cones setter, general labor for set up/tear down. Office help for check in and scoring

Misc Positions: passing out ribbons, gate steward, and Assistant scorer

Gate/Paddock Marshall: gate person(s) opens and closes gate to allow participants into the ring, making sure the correct competitors enter the correct class. At the obstacle arena, there is no physical gate. Here the gate person(s) is responsible for keeping track of waiting participants to ensure that only one participant is allowed into the area at a time and in proper order.

Ring steward: The ring steward is in the ring with the judge and is responsible for communicating judge's instructions to participants and with the announcer/steward as needed. Requires standing and appropriate dress. Business casual and a hat(I have a hat to provide if needed)

Timer: Timers are needed at the obstacle arena.

Cone setter/spotter: Cone setters reset the obstacle that are dislodged between participants.

Passing ribbons: appropriate dress required.

Gate for admission: collect admissions and control those entering

Assistant announcer: this person assists the announcer in getting things in order of placing's for the announcer to read.

General labor: For tear down and set up

Scribe: for Saturday morning 7 am-midmorning
